

**Program Administrator Report  
Triumph Gulf Coast Board Meeting  
March 9, 2022**

The Triumph Gulf Coast staff continues regular work with grantees on the implementation of 38 active projects, with an additional eight projects completed, totaling over \$304,000,000. Staff monitors and reviews projects for compliance and processes requests for funds on an ongoing basis, and continues to work with applicants and potential applicants, to review pre-applications, applications and to negotiate agreements.

The 2020-2021 Auditor General's audit is ongoing.

**Pre-Applications**

As of Friday, March 4, 2022 Triumph Gulf Coast had received 268 Pre-Applications totaling over \$1,951,715,000 in requests.
